Criteria used for the Carver Award:

- Senior at Northpoint Homeschool Academy
- Minimum GPA of 3.25
- Minimum GPA in high school science courses of 3.5
- Application, including current high school transcript and essay answer

To apply for the Carver Award please make a hard copy of the application paper, high school transcript, and essay and turn them into the office of Northpoint Homeschool Academy by Feb. 1st, 2024.

**The scholarship committee can decide to award one, two, or no Carver Awards in a given year. Decisions will be based on the strength of the applicants.*
